	Ability West	Just a Minute of Patience ' – practical communication access tips for businesses and people working with the public.	To mark Social Inclusion Week 2024, Ability West are designing posters for Galway Businesses and Public Services that contain tips for inclusive communication for people working in customer facing roles (cafes, restaurants, banks, pharmacy). One way to encourage social inclusion and participation is to ensure people in these essential community roles are aware of the ways they can make their communication more inclusive, and put in to practise simple strategies that can make interactions enjoyable and successful. These tips include “Patience in Communication” and “providing more time”. When these strategies are used, people who benefit from communication supports experience success and it is a step towards inclusion and participation in the local community. The poster will use visual reminders alongside the strategies to support a communication friendly and inclusive environment. There will be a QR code of the tips, and a link to a Micro-Credential course on Inclusive Businesses in University of Galway to allow for more people to access and share the resource.
